

HOW STUDENTS DISCOVERED THEIR CAMPUS FOOD PANTRY




MEALS & NUTRITION

98% of students reported accessing their campus pantry

REASONS FOR PANTRY VISITS

- 48%** I didn't want to run out of food.
- 47%** I ran out of food, and was worried to spend money to buy more.
- 38%** I ran out of food and didn't have time to buy food/groceries.
- 36%** I use the pantry to supplement my nutritional needs, bcl don't have enough money to cover all the food I need.
- 35%** I didn't have time to prepare food.
- 22%** I ran out of food and didn't have any money to buy more.


Which meals and/or snacks do you access from your campus food pantry on a weekly basis?



Do you have special nutritional needs?




To what extent does your campus food pantry meet your nutritional needs?




PANTRY QUALITY RATINGS



Would you recommend the food pantry to your peers in need?




Has the food pantry improved your sense of campus belonging?

HOW STUDENTS FOUND OUT ABOUT CALFRESH
